



Camp Rules

1. Be respectful of others: don't cause harm to others or their property.
2. Be safe: don't go anywhere off of campus, don't go anywhere unsupervised, and don't do anything that could be considered dangerous. If you feel the need to say "Hey, watch this" before you do something, it is probably not wise to do that.
3. Be healthy: take your medicine and don't do something that will get you or someone else hurt. All Medicines are to be turned into the nurse. Students must be accompanied by an adult when they go to the nurse.
4. Be where you need to be, when you need to be there, including curfew: don't go into anyone else's cabin, don't be late, don't be out past curfew.
5. Be a good walker: students may not ride on any vehicles on campus, except for emergencies. Sponsors, please park vehicles in designated areas.
6. Be modest: students should ensure that they are within dress code. Shorts must be at least fingertip length while standing up straight and arms down to your side, tank tops must cover the equivalent of space as your index, middle, and ring finger placed together, bathing suits for ladies must be one piece or should have a dark covering while swimming, and shirts and shoes must be worn at all times across campus, even if you are going to or from swimming.
7. Be legal: no alcohol, drugs, smoking, weapons, fireworks, pets, or personal vehicles.
8. Be appropriate: no public displays of affection (PDA)
9. Be wise: adhere to sponsor directives, even if they are not from your church.
10. Be unplugged: NO CELL PHONES! We ask all students to turn in their phones to their sponsors. If leaders see a phone, they will ask you to hand it over til the end of the week.
